VERONA SHUTTLE: 7. DEPARTURE IMPLEMENTED SUCCESSFULLY

6 + 1= 7! Already before the summer, we increased the weekend capacity of the "Verona Shuttle" by an additional departure in both directions between the terminals "Skandinavienkai" in Lübeck-Travemünde and the "Quadrante Europa" in Verona. This makes intermodal transport to Italy or between Italy and Northern Europe even more flexible. CO2 BALANCE 2020: 23,000 TONS LESS CO2 EMISSIONS

Our intermodal transport services with more than 34,000 units over a road distance of around 21,000,000 km saved greenhouse gas emissions of more than 23,000 tons of CO2 equivalents in 2020. That is around 68% less CO2 emissions compared to equivalent road transport consignments. RIGA VIA LIEPAJA: "ONE-STOP-SHOP" NETWORK EXPANDING TO THE EAST



SMART-EXPRESS: WE ARE EXPANDING PARCEL TRANSPORT TO ARMENIA


Our Smart-Express service stands for reliable and fast parcel consignments from Germany to Armenia by truck without reloading, including the highest quality standards. The shipping status can be tracked at any time during the short transport period via a tracking ID. The service will be expanded from October to include Austria, the Netherlands and Belgium. Parcel consignments from these countries first go to the central warehouse in Lübeck before continuing safe onward transport to Armenia. UPM: TWO MORE YEARS AS LEAD LOGISTICS PROVIDER

A look at history shows that the roots of European Cargo Logistics GmbH up to 1999 lie in the Finnish company UPM-Kymmene Distribution GmbH. After being sold to Lübecker Hafen-Gesellschaft mbH, it was renamed European Cargo Logistics GmbH (ECL GmbH). We have been a close partner of UPM ever since. The recently signed contract extension as lead logistics provider with UPM for a further two years was therefore a logical step.





OWN COMBINED TRANSPORT TRAILERS: WE ARE EXPANDING OUR FLEET

Up to now, three of our own, craneable CT trailers have been used primarily on the Lübeck - Ludwigshafen route - our Rhein-Neckar Shuttle - including onward trucking. From October we will be expanding our own fleet to include three more craneable CT trailers including ECL tarp cover, thereby doubling the load capacity. PAPER CARGOES: EXPANSION OF TRANSPORT ROUTE TO THE BENELUX COUNTRIES

Since mid-July 2021, we have been expanding our transport service for paper units to include additional deliveries from Lübeck to the Benelux countries (Belgium, the Netherlands and Luxembourg). The scheduled annual amount is currently around 20,000 tons. The transport consignments include loads from the smallest batches (general cargo) to full loads. About two years ago, the Lübeck Port Authority (LPA) laid a train-length track, including an open area, next to the port area in Schlutup to facilitate the unloading of bulk goods via a conveyor belt. From Schlutup it is only a short hop over Travemünder Allee to the A226 or Al motorway or in the direction of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania.
